Below are the number of doses and each vaccine required for school entry. Changes for this year include the Hepatitis A vaccine requirement for grades K & 1.

Hep B The minimum age for the 3rd dose of Hepatitis B is 24 weeks of age.

DTaP Four doses of DTaP/DTP/DT are acceptable if 4th dose was administered on or after child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.

Polio Three doses of Polio are acceptable for all grade levels if the third dose was given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and at least 6 months after the previous dose with only one type of vaccine used (all OPV or all IPV). For students in grades kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade, the final dose must be administered on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, and be administered at least 6 months after the previous dose.

Live Vaccines (MMR, Varicella & LAV) Live vaccines that are not administered on the same day must be administered a minimum of 28 days apart. The second dose should be repeated if the doses are separated by less than 28 days.

Varicella Physician documentation of disease history, including month and year, is proof of immunity for children entering preschool through 7<sup>th</sup> grade. Parental report of disease history is acceptable for grades 8-12.

Tdap There is no minimum interval from the last Td dose.

MC/4 Individuals who receive dose 1 after their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday only need 1 dose of MC/4.

Hep A The minimum interval between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of Hepatitis A is 6 calendar months.

Hep B The minimum age for the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose of Hepatitis B is 24 weeks of age.

DTaP Four doses of DTaP/DTP/DT are acceptable if 4<sup>th</sup> dose was administered on or after child's 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.

Polio Three doses of Polio are acceptable for all grade levels if the third dose was given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and at least 6 months after the previous dose with only one type of vaccine used (all OPV or all IPV). For students in grades kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade, the final dose must be administered on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, and be administered at least 6 months after the previous dose.

Live Vaccines (MMR, Varicella & LAV) Live vaccines that are not administered on the same day must be administered a minimum of 28 days apart. The second dose should be repeated if the doses are separated by less than 28 days.

Varicella Physician documentation of disease history, including month and year, is proof of immunity for children entering preschool through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Parental report of disease history is acceptable for grades 9-12.

Tdap There is no minimum interval from the last Td dose.

MC/4 Individuals who receive dose 1 on or after their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday only need 1 dose of MC/4.

Hep A The minimum interval between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of Hepatitis A is 6 calendar months.

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
